It's that time of year - Flu Season is Here!

We are pleased to announce the start of our flu vaccination campaign in September. There will be flu clinics available here **during October** and into **November**.

Please wait until you have been invited before you book your

appointment. We will be sending texts out in the upcoming weeks ahead to those who are clinically vulnerable and eligible for the vaccination first.

Why it's even more important to get a Flu Jab?

The COVID 19 pandemic has put a lot of additional stress on the NHS which is still felt across the nation's hospitals & GP surgeries (primary care).

Flu can be serious and each year thousands of people are admitted to hospital with severe forms of this common illness, which may be prevented by having the flu vaccine. So to help prevent hospitals becoming overstretched with preventable admissions, we are encouraging patients to have a flu jab, so we have extended our flu vaccination campaign from last year to now include: All 50 year olds, school aged children from 4 to 16, patients aged 6 months- 50 years with underlying health conditions.

SO WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR A VACCINE WITH US?

CLINICALLY VULNERABLE CHILDREN

• All clinically vulnerable children aged 6mth-18yrs – will be invited by the practice to have their vaccine

ALL OTHER SCHOOL AGED CHILDREN

• All other school aged children from age 4 - 16 (including children who turned 16yrs by 31st August 2021) – will be given the vaccine at their school by Sirona Healthcare.

INTRAMUSCULAR INACTIVATED FLU (Porcine Gelatine Content):

Sirona will also be offering the intramuscular inactivated flu vaccine to any children who decline the Fluenz (nasal spray) vaccine due to its porcine gelatine content – This will be offered to children over the next few months in a 'catch-up' along with any other children that missed the vaccine or who are home schooled. ELLIGIBLE ADULTS (for a vaccine here at the practice)

- Adults aged 50yrs and over
- **Pregnant Women** •
- Carers (who are officially recognised as carers)
- Patients who live with or care for Immunocompromised individuals
- Patients in 'long-stay' residential care homes

FRONTLINE HEALTHCARE EMPLOYEES

All frontline health and social care workers are expected to have the flu vaccine to protect those they care for.

Frontline Health & Social Care staff, who are employed by:

- A registered 'domiciliary' care provider
- A registered residential care or nursing home
- A voluntary managed hospice provider

ALL OTHER PATIENTS

Other Patients who are not eligible for a flu vaccine here, but would like one, may be able to get a flu vaccine privately from participating local pharmacies – please check with your pharmacy over the upcoming weeks for advice.
