Have you, or do you know someone who has, experienced FGM?

You can talk to the clinic in confidence

The Bristol Community Rose clinic supports women who have experienced FGM, female genital mutilation. It's also known as female circumcision or cutting, and by other terms, such as Sunna, gudniin, halalays, tahur, megrez and khitan.

The clinic gives women the chance to discuss their physical and mental health needs relating to their FGM in a sensitive and non-judgmental environment.

This specialist service is staffed by an all-female team who understand the complexities of FGM. We always have access to telephone interpreters and we also have a health care advocate available when requested. You may wish to bring a friend to translate or for support and they will be welcome.

The Rose clinic has a dedicated counsellor to discuss matters that arise from the consultations and all clinic appointments are confidential.

We are able to offer this service to all women over the age of 18 who are registered with a Bristol GP.
